A. Draft Ordinance - Proposed Charter Amendments

The City Commission accepted the Charter Review Advisory Committee's final report on October 23, 2023 and reviewed their recommendations for proposed amendments to the City Charter. Staff has conducted research as requested by the City Commission and is looking for further guidance on charter amendment ballot language in order to bring back the ordinance for consideration on first reading at the November 27, 2023 regular City Commission meeting.

B. Draft Resolution - Proposed Revisions to the Code of Boardmanship Policy

The Charter Review Advisory Committee made a recommendation in its final report that the City Commission approve a Resolution with suggested revisions to the Code of Boardmanship that provide for possible sanctions for City Commissioners. At their October 23, 2023 regular meeting, the City Commission agreed to hold a workshop on October 31, 2023 to further discuss the draft Resolution and proposed revisions to the Code of Boardmanship Policy.
